Overview

The United States Coast Guard (USCG) Operations Systems Center (OSC) released version 3.3 of the National Vessel Movement Center Web Application on 26 May 2015. The majority of the application's graphical layout remains the same; however, the "Subscribe" tab has been removed and several content-related changes have been made. A detailed listing and description of these changes, including images, comparing the current and new versions of the application follows.
