Overview

The United States Coast Guard (USCG) Operations Systems Center (OSC) released version 3.3 of the National Vessel Movement Center Web Application on 26 May 2015. The majority of the application's graphical layout remains the same. A detailed listing and description of the changes, including images comparing the current and new versions of the application follows.

Summary

There are primarily two changes within the NVMC website affecting this release. The "Subscribe" tab has been removed and several content-related changes have been made to support removal of this tab. Additionally, with the planned retirement of the NOAD InfoPath Template, the NOAD InfoPath Template has been removed from the Downloads tab, so that new users do not continue to initiate use of this template. The template offering was also removed because it was not slated to be updated with the latest schema modifications, due to its planned retirement.

Work included within this release is summarized as follows:

- The **Subscribe** tab has been removed.
- Information regarding subscribing to email notifications has been added to the **Contact Us** tab.
- The **NOAD InfoPath Template** has been removed from the system.
- The **NOAD InfoPath Template** links have been removed from the **Downloads** tab.
